





#### Update on progress towards the appointment of our new Priest-in-Charge

Work is continuing on the next stage towards making an appointment, the production of the Benefice Profile, which will be sent to potential candidates for the post. Each PCC has now drawn up its own Parish Page and a sub group representing all the parishes has worked on the overall Benefice aspects. The full Benefice Standing Committee, with representatives of all our Parishes, has unanimously approved the draft Profile, which has now been sent to the Diocese. Once the draft has been returned to us, and any remaining work on it done, it will be turned into a well laid out, illustrated document, and when all is completed and approved we will be able, working with the Carlisle Diocese, to proceed to advertising the post. There will be further Magazine updates as progress continues.

#### **Operation Christmas Child Shoeboxes update**

Operation Christmas Child have confirmed that the shoeboxes collected from Monkhill in November made their way to Moldova in Eastern Europe. Moldova is situated north east of Romania with a population of 3,250,532 with 18% under the age of 15 (source – CIA The World Factbook). Operation Christmas Child sent the following message "We thank God for the thousands of childen who have received shoeboxes here since we began outreach events. While we are unable to provide information on the specific child/ren who received your individual shoebox/es, we hope you will be inspired by the following story about Ana".

"Ana is from a village in Moldova where there is extreme poverty. She had been wanting a baby doll mentioning it many times around the house. Recently when shoebox gifts were distributed in her area, Ana opened the lid of her shoebox to find the exact baby doll she had longed for. Surprised and beaming, she picked up the doll and hugged it close to her chest".
